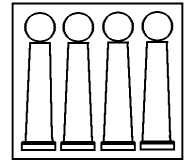

Scott replaces Walther as BCBA Editor

After six and one half years as the editor of the Boone County Bar Association *Newsletter*, Skip Walther will turn over his responsibilities to Steve Scott effective with the publication of next month's edition.

Steve Scott will come in with considerable experience as he founded the *Newsletter* in May, 1986 at the request of then Bar President Darwin Hindman, and continued as editor until August, 1994. Scott also serves as the Webmaster for the BCBA website.

Effective January 1, 2002, the *Focus on Kids* fee will increase from \$35.00 to \$40.00 per participant. See Local Rule 68.6 and Section 452.600, RSMo for rules regarding participation in this important program. This is the first fee increase since the program was implemented in 1995.
