Casey Clevenger Appointed Drug Court Commissioner

On Tuesday, October 27, the 13th Judicial Circuit Court en Banc unanimously appointed Casey Clevenger as the Drug Court Commissioner. Clevenger, currently serving as Assistant Prosecutor in Callaway County, will begin her appointment on November 30. This will be the new Division 12 for the circuit.

"I am pleased to announce on behalf of the 13th Circuit that Casey Clevenger will be the new Drug Court Commissioner," Presiding Judge Christine Carpenter said. "Our circuit has grown from one treatment court in 1999 to six in 2015. The addition of the Commissioner to oversee the treatment courts will ensure those courts continue to grow and improve. I know Casey will excel in this position and I look forward to see what impact she will make in Boone and Callaway counties."

The circuit worked with local legislators, primarily Senator **Kurt Schaefer** and Representative **Chris Kelly**, in a two year process to change statutory authority to allow the circuit to request a commissioner, and then to fund the commissioner. Clevenger was one of 70 applicants for the position.

"I am honored and humbled to have been selected by the Court en Banc for this position," Clevenger said. "I know that I have big shoes to fill as the new Drug Court Commissioner. I am looking forward to working closely with Judge Christine Carpenter and Judge Carol England as I transition into this position. Their knowledge and experience have made these programs the success they are today. I became a prosecutor to improve the quality of life for the members of my community, and I hope to continue that mission as the drug court commissioner. I have a solid foundation to start the ground running as commissioner due mostly to my professional mentors Bob Sterner and Chris Wilson. What they have taught me over the past nine years at the Callaway County Prosecuting Attorney's Office has been extraordinary, and I thank them for everything."

Clevenger has been assistant prosecutor in Callaway County since December 2006, has served as the New Bloomfield municipal judge since January 2010.

13th Circuit Accepting Applications for 2016 Family Court Mediators

The 13th Judicial Circuit is now accepting applications for their 2016 list of Court Approved Family Court Mediators. Supreme Court of Missouri Rule 88.05 requires a mediator in a contested child custody matter to be an attorney or to possess graduate degree in a field that includes the study of psychiatry, psychology, social work, counseling or other behavioral science substantially related to marriage and family interpersonal relationships. This rule also mandates that a mediator has received a minimum of 20 hours of child custody mediation training in a program approved by the court. Local Court Rule 68.16(C) requires mediators to obtain an additional 6 hours of mediation-related training every two years, using The Missouri Bar's reporting period.

Applicants must submit an application form and certificate of completion of hours taken. Please submit your completed application by December 30, 2015 to Cindy Garrett, Deputy Court Administrator, 13th Judicial Circuit, Boone County Courthouse, 705 E. Walnut St., Columbia, MO 65201.
