Attorneys and Law Students Needed January 13-14 for Mock Trial Tournament

Columbia College and the University of Missouri Columbia are hosting an Undergraduate Mock Trial Invitational Tournament competition at the University of Missouri Columbia on Friday January 13 and Saturday January 14, 2016. The tournament hosts need attorneys and law students to serve as judges for this four-round tournament, which serves as a forum for teams to practice their skills for the regional tournament held in Kansas City in February. Judges will score a printed ballot with established criteria and rule on evidentiary objections governed by an evidence code similar to the Federal Rules of Evidence.

This year's case is a civil employment discrimination case. Judges are needed for any and all rounds, which are as follows:

Round 1 – Friday, January 13 1:30 p.m. –4:30 p.m Round 2 – Friday, January 13 6:30 p.m. – 9:30 p.m. Round 3 – Saturday, January 14 9:00a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Round 4 – Saturday, January 14 1:30 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Judicial Commission seeks applicants for Teitelman vacancy on Supreme Court

The Appellate Judicial Commission announced today that it is accepting applications for judge of the Supreme Court of Missouri to fill the vacancy created by the November 29, 2016, death of Judge Richard B. Teitelman.

Citizens are encouraged to nominate well-qualified candidates for the commission's consideration. The Missouri Constitution requires that a judge of the Supreme Court of Missouri be at least 30 years old, licensed to practice law in Missouri, a United States citizen for at least 15 years and a qualified Missouri voter for at least nine years next preceding selection. Nominations should be submitted to the commission by e-mail at JudgeVacancy@courts.mo.gov or by postal mail to Supreme Court of Missouri Judge Vacancy, Post Office Box 150, Jefferson City, MO 65102. The nomination form is available online through http://www.courts.mo.gov/page.jsp?id=108321.

Applications will be accepted until 5 p.m. Friday, February 3, 2017.

The commission expects to meet Monday and Tuesday, February 27 and 28, 2017, at the Supreme Court Building at 207 West High Street in Jefferson City, to interview applicants and select a panel of three nominees for the governor's consideration. The interviews will be open to the public. The names of those to be interviewed and information relating to the number and characteristics of all applicants will be released publicly prior to the beginning of the interviews.

Boone County Attorney Brian Taylor Passes January 1, 2017

Brian Taylor, a Boone County attorney who served as a staff attorney at Mid-Missouri Legal Services for several years, died on Sunday, January 1, 2017. Originally from Neosho, Brian moved to Mid-Missouri late in his career and devoted his final years to advocating for low-income and disabled people. Prior to leaving MMLS due to declining health in 2013, Brian developed and implemented successful uncontested legal clinics at MMLS that already have benefited hundreds of Mid-Missouri families and continue in effect today. Always humble, Brian requested that no funeral or memorial service be held to honor him. He requested instead that contributions be made in his memory to Mid-Missouri Legal Services, 1201 West Broadway, Columbia MO 65203.
