U.S. District and Bankruptcy Courts to Upgrade CM/ECF Systems

On April 23, 2018, the U.S. District and Bankruptcy Courts for the Western District of Missouri will upgrade their to the Next Generation of Case Management and Electronic Case Files ("CM/ECF") system. The District Court's CM/ECF system will NOT be available from Friday, April 20th, at 3 p.m. until Monday morning, April 23rd.

Once upgraded, filers will need to perform two simple actions in order to file in Federal Court, including 1) Obtain a PACER account and/or upgrade it to the new system (shared accounts cannot be used), and 2) link the upgraded PACER account to their current District Court CM/ECF account.

Make checks payable to "Boone County Bar Association." Dues become payable January 1, and members will be removed from the rolls if they have not paid dues by April 1, 2018. Pursuant to the recent Amendment to the By-Laws, **dues are no longer waived for sitting and retired judges**, but continue to be waived for members who have reached 75 years of age, or have been licensed for 50 years.

As of April 1, out of 366 members of the BCBA, only 196 have submitted their annual dues. Those BCBA members that have not paid will receive an e-mail from the BCBA with one last reminder. Please pay attention to that email. If you have not paid, please submit payment a.s.a.p. If you receive the email and have paid, please respond to it so we can correct our records and keep you from mistakenly being removed from the rolls.
