City of Columbia Hiring an Assistant City Counselor

The City of Columbia Law Department is accepting applications for an Assistant City Counselor. This position serves as a member of the legal team to provide professional services to City officials, staff, boards and commissions; provides legal advice on diverse areas of municipal law to City researches and creates legal departments; documents and opinions; represents the City before agencies administrative and other forums. The open position is in the Counselor/Civil Division. This is advanced professional work that



requires the ability to communicate complex ideas effectively, both orally and in writing. A thorough knowledge of legal issues affecting local government is required. The attorney will work with city staff and select appointed boards and commissions. Possession of a Juris Doctorate from an accredited law school and a valid license to practice law in Missouri is required. Minimum three years of experience is required; experience in local government or public sector law is highly preferred. The starting salary ranges from \$65,437-\$85,114/year, depending on qualifications. HOURS: Monday-Friday; generally 8-5 with occasional evening and weekend work required. NOTE: Please describe your strengths related to Essential Job Functions in a cover letter.

Position is open until filled. The preferred application date is Friday, March 18, 2022.

Missouri Public Defender Hiring Trial Attorneys, District Defender



The Missouri State Public Defender System is hiring trial attorneys/assistant public defenders for vacancies in positions located throughout the state. Duties include pre-trial and trial preparation; litigating all aspects of the case through disposition at the trial court level; promoting and protecting the best interest of the client at all times; maintaining client contact by telephone, appointments, or institutional visits; keeping client apprised of investigations, negotiations, and court rulings; appearing at regularly scheduled court dockets and all appearances concerning assigned caseload; drafting motions and pleadings.

Mid-Missouri Legal Services Seeking Judicare Attorneys

Mid-Missouri Legal Services sustained a loss of Judicare attorneys during COVID. MMLS is seeking private family law attorneys licensed in Missouri to handle simple family law cases at a reduced fee through our Judicare program. MMLS pays Judicare attorneys at the rate of \$70 hourly with a maximum amount based on the type of case. However, if the case requires additional time due to unexpected complexity or more hearings than usual, MMLS will grant a waiver of the maximum fee and pay the attorney for the approved extra time. Please note that MMLS assigns more complex cases, including those that involve domestic or sexual violence, to its in-house staff attorneys. MMLS hopes that attorneys will seriously consider this opportunity to contribute to the community if you are an experienced attorney or, if you are a new lawyer, to acquire valuable experience. MMLS provides access to family law forms and advice from our experienced staff attorneys.
