#### Court En Banc approves updates to Local Court Rules

The Judges of the 13th Circuit recently approved updates to our Local Court Rules regarding Family Law Settlement Conferences and Civil Motions to Compel discovery, LR 68.12 and LR 32.4 respectively.

This update to Local Court Rule 68.12 went into effect on August 28, 2022. And the update to Local Court Rule 32.4 will take effect on October 30, 2022. The Court's press release regarding these updates is available here.
