Judge **Kayla Jackson-Williams** was sworn in as the new 13th Circuit Division 10 judge in a ceremony January 20 at the Boone County Courthouse. Judge Jackson-Williams is a former litigator with Rogers | Ehrhardt and the Missouri State Public Defender's office. She is the first Black judge to serve in Boone County.

After the ceremony, Judge Jackson-Williams said to KOMU, ""I feel nothing but love, and I love everyone who was in this room today. It was a journey and it was a journey that I take with everyone in various capacity, so overwhelmed would be the most appropriate word."
