Public Access to Case.net Documents, New Rule Requires Redaction in Court Filings

Starting July 1, 2023, Case.net will have expanded public access, fulfilling a long-term goal of the Missouri judiciary to allow the public to have increased remote access to case documents. The 13th Circuit will have expanded public access by September 1, though public access will be retroactively available to July 1.

Because of the expanded access, also starting on July 1, 2023, attorney filers on Case.net will be required to certify they have complied with their obligations to



redact confidential information. The judiciary is working on a mechanism to allow filers to correct mistakes while protecting potentially confidential information from public view. **Presiding Judge Brouck Jacobs** published a statement on the matter on March 2, 2023, which is available here. The new Supreme Court rule regarding redaction requirements may be found here.


Amy Henderson Named Member-Owner of Cripps & Simmons

Attorney/Assistant Public Defender openings throughout the state, including in Columbia and Fulton.

As of March 1, an APD I will have a starting salary of \$60,000, and an APD II will have a salary of \$65,000.

The system also has an opening in the Kansas City trial office for a Deputy District Defender and an opening for an Assistant Public Defender for the Kansas City Children's Defense Team. There is also an opening for a Capital PCR attorney in the Columbia or Kansas City office.
